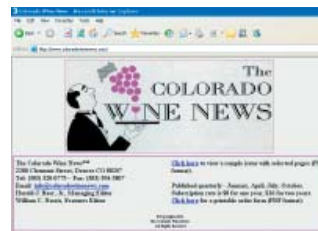
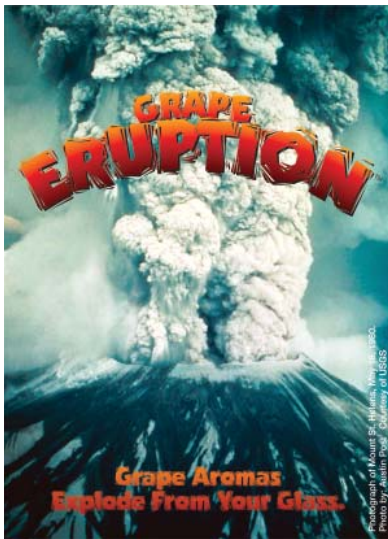
## May 18, 2005

This 100% Niagara varietal wine has a wild flower and foxy nose before soft, slightly off-dry flavors of dried apricot, dried pears, and sweet apple which finish at the back of the palate.”
