Toast of the Tunes returns Thursday to Oak Knoll south of Hillsboro

Old Elbows headlines this week's concert Thursday night at Oak Knoll Winery just off Oregon 219 this Thursday night. The concert is the third of six in the winery's annual Toast to the Tunes summer concert series. Festivities kick off at 6 pm and run until 9 pm at the winery located at 29700 SW Burkhalter Road, not far from Farmington View Elementary School.

The quintet plays a variety of blues and rock music, and they can often be caught at a local McMenamin. Oak Knoll's next concert is Thursday August 5th and features Rock Residue.

Although you can bring your own food, no outside beverages are allowed at the concerts. Beverages are available for purchase, as is food. Pulled pork sandwiches from the James Gang are the featured dish. Admission is \$5 for those over 21, with everyone else getting in for free.

Started in 1970, the Oak Knoll Winery is the oldest in the county, and has also been the largest in the county. They produce a variety of wines, but they do not grow their own grapes.
