36% Wirtz Vineyard
64% Sheppard Vineyard

WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

These grapes came from the Sheppard and Wirtz Vineyards. We have 598 cases of it, but we expect it to sell quickly. This Riesling has a higher acid and more fruit than the Muller Thurgau. Riesling is a later-ripening variety and, because the fruit and acid are nicely balanced, this is a very food friendly wine.
