GROWING SEASON:

These grapes came from Sheppard Vineyard, which is only about twelve miles from our winery. We made just 46 cases of this wine, and will release it only to our wine club. There is an acidic bite to the finish of this Pinot Gris, which makes it a bit of a departure from our usual style. It is for this reason that we decided to release this only to our wine club; it is new and different and special, and it is wonderful with seafood.

TASTING NOTES:

The 2011 Pinot Gris opens with a zesty bouquet of citrus notes and white stone fruit. A fresh rain aroma lingers at the close of the nose. On the palate more bright citrus notes are displayed, grapefruit and Meyer lemon. Golden plums and nectarine shine through in the clean finish.
